# APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

## 2017 Juried Student Art Exhibition

Dates of exhibition: Exhibition dates are September 5 to November 4, 2017

### Qualifications for Submission:

1. If you were a student enrolled in ANY art, architecture or photography course at ELAC *since* the summer semester 2015, you are eligible to submit your artwork for the 2016 Juried Student Art Exhibition.
2. Your artwork must have been completed *anytime* during the 2016–2017 academic year (this includes summer 2016, fall 2016, winter 2016, and spring 2017).
3. Your work does *not* need to be related to a class assignment.
4. Work in any medium is accepted including graphic design and animation.
5. Maximum artwork size is 5 ft. x 7ft (2-d); 5ft x 5ft x 5ft (3-D). We do provide bases for 3-D artwork. Artwork larger than these dimensions will be disqualified.
6. Submission is *not* a guarantee of inclusion in the exhibition; artwork for the show will be selected by professional curators or artists who will serve as jurors.

### When to submit:

1. You must submit your artwork during the following dates and times *only*:  
June 6, 2017, 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.  
June 7, 2017, 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.  
June 8, 2017, 12 p.m. to 6 p.m.  
(VPAM will not be accepting early or late submissions)

### How to submit

1. Application forms will be available in the VPAM lobby.
2. Obtain and complete an "Application Form" for EACH artwork you enter (maximum is 3 artworks per person).
3. There is no entry fee for this exhibition.
4. ***NEW:*** your work does not have to be "gallery ready" in order to be submitted. This means that your work does not have to be framed or mounted before you submit it. In other words, you do not need to think about the hardware you will need to display it. However, your artwork must be complete when you submit it and you will not be able to change it once it has been submitted.  
If the jurors select your work for the show, you will be able to pick up your work and spend the summer making your work "gallery ready." We will offer a free workshop(s) in the summer to help you prepare your artwork (cutting mattes, choosing display techniques). If you are showing a digital piece for a computer or monitor, we will help you choose viewing equipment.
5. If you submit a wall piece, please place an arrow pointing "up" on the reverse of the piece. (It is also important to write your name on the back, too).

6. For pieces that have more than one part, please provide clear instructions, with a sketch, of how the parts work together.
7. There will be no insurance coverage for this exhibition. Neither the academic departments, nor VPAM, nor ELAC will be responsible for broken, damaged or missing work. However, the utmost care will be taken to prevent any such occurrences.

**Where to submit:**

Bring your artwork and a fully completed application (one application per artwork) to building S1, Vincent Price Art Museum, lobby entrance.

**After you submit:**

A list naming all selected artworks will be made public and you will be notified if your piece(s) were selected for the show. If your work is not selected, you will need to make arrangements to collect your work. If your artwork is selected, you will be able to pick up your artwork over the summer to make it "gallery ready"; then you'll bring it back for the show.

**Exhibition dates are September 5 to November 4, 2017.**

All artworks selected to be in the exhibition must remain part of the show until the closing date. If this is a problem for you, please talk with the museum staff. Your artwork will remain part of the show until closing date on November 4, 2017. No exceptions will be made.

**Opening Reception Tuesday, September 5, 2017 from 6pm to 8pm.**

Jurors' prizes will be made public at the Opening Reception.
